ANNOUNCEMENT -- NEIGHBORHOOD PURPOSE GRANTS

We encourage schools to apply for the Encino Neighborhood Council (ENC) competitive neighborhood purpose grants. The ENC is funded by the Los Angeles Department of Neighborhood Empowerment (DONE). ENC allocates a portion of its funding to improve schools that serve Encino residents in general studies kindergarten through adult education. The ENC has authorized funding of **up to \$4,000** to be distributed to selected elementary, middle, and secondary public schools. Projects will be awarded by the ENC Education Committee, with approval by the ENC board which has final decision-making authority. Each applicant will receive an on-site visit by Education Committee members. Awards will be decided at the ENC March 22, 2023 meeting, with schools informed by April 1, 2023.

DEADLINE Applications must be submitted no later than March 8, 2023 for consideration this AY.
