Agenda Item 7: Amend Proposed New Sanding Rule 14: Fees for copying.

13. Copying Costs for Requests for Copies of Records. Requested copies of public records will be produced at a charge of One Dollar (\$1.00) per request, plus ten cents (\$.10) for each page, plus the actual costs of staff time in excess of the first thirty (30) minutes for ~~retrieving and~~ duplicating the document(s).

Agenda Item 8: Amend ARTICLE V, SECTION 2A:

A. **President.** The President shall be the principal officer of the Council and shall be the presiding officer at meetings of the Council and shall exercise and perform such other duties s the Council may assign from time to time or the bylaws may prescribe. The President shall have the power to issue, modify and revoke executive orders to carry out resolutions of the Council or to implement the bylaws or standing rules.

Agenda Item 9: Amend ARTICLE VI, SECTION 2:

Section 2: Minutes. ~~Within Minutes of meetings shall be prepared and made available to the Council office as soon as reasonably practicable. At least seven business days seventy-two (72) hours prior to the next scheduled following each regular~~ Council meeting, minutes of the prior meeting shall be sent by mail, fax or electronic mail to all Representatives of the Council and such others in the community that have provided current contact information to the Council or as the Council directs.

Agenda Item 10: Amend Standing Rule 6:

6. Committee Procedures. Committee meetings scheduled back to back should be avoided with a strong preference to have only one meeting scheduled per day and not to have meetings during normal work hours. Committee Agendas should show the committee members. Committee Chairs shall coordinate the meeting dates through the Council office before posting notices to avoid conflicting meetings. Committee recommendations shall be decided by majority vote committee members voting. A minority report, if submitted, is to be provided with a majority report when a recommendation is made to the Council. The vote count must be shown on the recommendation. [Adopted 9-29-05]
