- A. POP UP Art Event at the Park Last month Nora Ross made a presentation regarding a pop up art event at Encino Park. The event is tentatively scheduled for August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019. We have received an NPG requesting \$5,000. Discussion on the NPG.
