

## CALLS FOR SERVICE PRINTOUT COLUMN DEFINITIONS

<b>RD</b>	Reporting District - Area in which incident occurred
<b>TIME</b>	Time when incident was reported to LAPD Communications Division
<b>UNIT</b>	Identification number of LAPD patrol vehicle.
<b>ARVD</b>	Time when LAPD arrived at the location.
<b>CALL</b>	Type of call (see Pages 2 and 3)
<b>CD</b>	Code - Call Priority Level (see below)
<b>DIS</b>	Disposition of the call (see below)
