1. Introductions including Dept. of Transportation engineer Ken Firoozmand.
2. Presentation and discussion of trouble spots in Encino:
 - a) Petit (S side) at Ventura Blvd. Need for a left hand arrow for the Northbound traffic in the afternoon hours. Driveways at Bank of America and Jerry's blocked.
 - b) Caribeth at Royal Hills Dr., poor visibility. Request for flashing warning light.
 - c) Extending peak hour parking restrictions Eastbound on Ventura Blvd. between Balboa and Sepulveda from 7:00 am to 10:00 am. Also discussion of enforcement.
 - d) Adding Peak hour parking restrictions Eastbound on Ventura Blvd. between Balboa and Hayvenhurst from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm.
 - e) Balboa (Northbound) south of Victory near the Busway in the afternoon rush hours. More green time for the Northbound traffic and better coordination of the lights.
 - f) Coordination of traffic lights near McDonalds 15700 Ventura Blvd. Long traffic backups Eastbound.
 - g) Request for study of White Oak at Burbank Blvd.
 - h) White Oak at Lindley and Busway – passive left hand turns. The turn pockets are more than filled up with cars waiting.
 - i) Hayvenhurst Southbound at Moorpark – better striping for left hand turns.
