MINUTES OF THE TRAFFIC/TRANSPORTATION MEETING 10/8/08

1. Change of Speed Limit to recertify radar enforcement re: basic speed law.
Motion: Silver, 2nd Rosen
Move to support the recommendation of the LADOT to increase the speed limit on the following streets:
Victory Blvd. between SD Freeway W to Desoto from 40 mph to 45 mph.
Balboa Blvd. between Ventura Blvd. and Burbank from 35 mph to 40 mph.
Balboa Blvd. between Burbank and Victory from 40 mph to 45 mph.
Vote: 5 in favor, 2 opposed
2. Advertising Trailers
Motion: Silver, 2nd Rosen
Move to recommend a letter to Councilman Weiss with CC to the LADOT requesting move for new ordinance to restrict curbside (in the street) advertising trailers.
Vote: 7 in favor, 0 opposed (**Consent Calendar**)
3. Request for Traffic Count
Motion: Woods, 2nd Kelson
Prior to the opening of Avalon Bay (at Noeline) and Woodrise (at Woodley) a traffic count at Woodley (S) to Valley Vista (E) 7-9 am and Densmore (N) to Valley Vista (W) 4-6 pm. Counts to be repeated 6 months after the opening of these projects.
Vote: 7 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstain
4. 16030 Ventura Blvd.
Motion: Martayan, 2nd C. Hand
Request to change the location of the loading zone West for safety. Letter to Councilman Weiss and LADOT.
Vote: 8 in favor, 0 opposed (**Consent Calendar**)
5. Libbit at Addison
Motion: Silver, 2nd Martayan
Letter to Councilman Weiss and LADOT to support an all-way stop at Libbit and Addison.
Vote: 7 in favor 0 opposed, 1 abstain
6. Board Comment:
Chair, Laurie Kelson, requests committee members become the eyes and ears of Encino. Please bring issues to the committee.
Old Business: Left-hand drop mailbox at the Balboa/Ventura Blvd. P.O. turned down by the property owner because the largest tenant, Smart and Final, wants the foot traffic. The drop box was supported by the Post Office.
