H<u>www.encinocouncil.or</u> g One of the most controversial proposed Charter amendments on the March 3, 2009 LA City Elections ballot is Measure B – known as the Solar Energy and Jobs Creation Program. According to Councilman Greig Smith, this ballot measure was approved by the City Council without knowing that a fiscal analysis "was withheld from Councilmembers".

Our Community Meeting on Wednesday, February 25th will feature a debate on Measure B between a representative of the LA Department of Water and Power and Ron Kaye, former editor of the Los Angeles Daily News. Although most everybody supports solar power, the controversy over Measure B has focused on the process used by the City Council to put this on the March 3rd ballot, how much it will cost, and that the work will be done by DWP workers without competitive bidding.

We will also hear presentations on a request for shared parking by the Skirball Cultural Center; a proposed zone change for townhomes south of Ventura Blvd near Petit Avenue and reconsideration of the signage "Encino Commons – The Valley's Miracle Mile" which still requires City permits.
