## 1. Baseline Hillside Ordinance

Proposed regulations affecting construction of homes and structures within any designated hillside area as to size, height, grading and other development restrictions to protect against out-of-scale development.

Motion: Support including ridgeline protection and retaining wall

limitations as part of the Hillside Baseline Ordinance"

Vote: 9-0 [Consent Calendar]

2. Wireless Telecommunications Facilities – Cell Phone Towers
Project Permit Case Nos: ZA 2010-18-CUB and DIR 2009 4082

Motion: Support Citywide ordinance regulating wireless telecommunication facilities including cell phone towers:

1. "With the City attorney's guidance and consistent with his recommendations, the City enact a comprehensive new ordinance with clear and consistent standards and procedures regulating all wireless telecommunications facilities in the City, authorizing regulation of aesthetics and providing protection to communities and residential neighborhoods to the full extent of the law." Passed

unanimously by voice vote.

- 2. "The City immediately impose a moratorium on all telecommunications facility installations in the City and/or applications for approval of such installations in the City." Mr. Silver 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Krokover amended to insert "stand alone wireless towers". Mr. Simon moved to refer back to committee. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Hamilton. Passed 14 in favor with1 abstention.
- 8. Public Hearing: Proposed increases in DWP Electric Rates. Mr. Silver moved that the ENC oppose that portion of the electric rate increase that goes for green power

conversion, solar and wind power energy until there is a significant improvement in the current economy. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Rosen. Mr. Glushon made a substitute motion: ENC ask the city council to overturn the action taken by the DWP board of commissioners except as to the electric rate increase and any rate increase to the actual and verifiable increase costs of providing electricity to rate payers and/or protect bond ratings. 2nd Mr. Noce 2<sup>nd</sup>. Unanimous approval of substitute motion.
