 - 2. MOTION: Movies at the Park The Outreach Committee will promote a "Movie at the Park" night. Possible date is July 22nd. Passed 4-0-0.
 - 3. Community Get Together To be held on June 11th possibly at Balboa Park. There are currently over 100 people interested in attending. Would like up to \$500 for related expenses (permits, etc...). Residents would bring their own picnics and food trucks can be invited. Two food trucks have expressed interest in being there.
