

**AGREEMENT OF CONDITIONS
TO GRANT
POLICE PERMIT**

PERMIT: **Police Commission Café Entertainment/Shows**

We, Maggie Shubat, Wael Derwich, Paul Siplian, and Mike Hanna, do fully recognize the necessity for the imposition of conditions set by the Board of Police Commissioners, upon issuance of a Café Entertainment/Shows (CES) Police Permits at 16925 Ventura Blvd, Encino, California 91316.

In consideration for granting of this permit, we do hereby agree to the following:

1. The business operator shall comply with section 6404.5 (c) of the California Labor Code and section 41.50(B) of the Los Angeles Municipal Code which prohibit the smoking of any substance within an enclosed place of employment and any outdoor dining area. The use of any type of smoking pipe (including hookah pipes) shall be prohibited in all enclosed areas of the establishment and in all outdoor dining areas.
2. If valet services are offered, the business operator shall only contract with valet companies permitted by the Police Commission.
3. Any music, or any other form of live entertainment, shall not be audible beyond 150 feet from the property line of the business location per Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Section 112.01(b). Additionally, the noise created by the music or other forms of live entertainment at the permittee's business shall not exceed the ambient noise level on the premises of any other occupied property by more than five (5) decibels per LAMC Section 112.01(c).
4. Permittees shall maintain an operational telephone number to receive citizen complaints. During business hours, the telephone number shall be answered by someone who is able to immediately address citizen complaints. For complaints received during non-business hours, the Permittees shall respond to citizen complaints within 24 hours. The hotline phone number shall be posted on the exterior front and rear walls of the establishment. A log containing the time, date, and nature of the complaint, and the resolution of the matter shall be maintained on the premises. A copy of the complaint log must be maintained on-site and be available for inspection by Los Angeles Police Department personnel.

We understand any violation of the foregoing conditions shall be grounds for suspension or revocation of the conditioned permits for which this document applies. I further understand that these conditions are subject to Board approval and may be modified prior to the granting of this permit to ensure that the best interests of the City and the public are met.
