**3a. 17500, 17524 & 17526 Burbank Boulevard:** The Planning and Land Use Committee will hear testimony from the Applicant and Neighbors on the advisability of the following project:

Application for Eldercare Unified Permit, Site Plan Review: The Applicant will be presenting a project to build a new six story Residential Care facility (Planning Case No. ZA-2021-5717-ELD-SPR) https://planning.lacity.org/pdiscaseinfo/search/encoded/MjQ4ODA20.

**Project Description:** The Applicant seeks to demolish and remove five single-story church/accessory buildings, consisting of the existing Bethel Church and Preschool, including approximately 19,487 square feet, in order to construct, use and maintain an approximately 284,859 square-foot Residential Care Facility for the Elderly built to a maximum of 89 feet and six stories, consisting of 238 units comprised of 206 dwelling units for both Independent and Assisted Living and 32 Dementia/Memory Care guest rooms, located at 17500 -17526 Burbank Boulevard within the RA-1-RIO Zone. Off-street parking is provided on-grade and below-grade within one subterranean parking level. The Subject Property is located within the Encino-Tarzana Community Plan Area and has a General Plan Land Use designation of Medium Residential.

- **3b**. The PLU should discuss <u>CF 12-0460-S4</u>, which is a Zoning Code / Reorganization of Administration Provisions (Processes and Procedures Ordinance) / Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) Amendment, a massive reorganization, consisting of 900+ pages of documentation. It might be a good idea for the PLU committee to examine this amendment and request the ENC send a Community Impact Statement to PLUM and City Council.
