There have been various proposals for more city storage facilities, it is time to get it done.
 - c. Closures of Board & Care Homes: See 2019 article. The situation is not better. About every 2 years there is a push to increase the reimbursement rates. See CF 19-0002-S184. CF 19-1516. CF 20-1206. Nothing happens, board & care homes continue to close. These facilities serve adult individuals, some with Severe Mental Illness, some elderly, in many cases having experienced homelessness. Most have no resources. Closure of these facilities is a direct pathway to the street.
