- 5. Old and New Business
- A. ONEGeneration Senior Symposium 2022 This year, the ONEGeneration Senior Symposium will be on, Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup> 2022 at the ONEGeneration campus. This will be like the event attended last year, which given the pandemic was well attended. The ENC has participated by sponsoring part of the lunch service and always has a booth at the event. MOTION: the ENC's Outreach Committee recommends that the board approve sponsoring part of the lunch at the ONEGeneration Senior Symposium, held on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at the ONEGeneration Campus and further requests \$1000 to participate and for a booth at the event. Discussion and possible action.
  - Alex G. introduced the item and moved the motion. Mike S. 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - The item was opened to committee discussion. There were a few comments from committee members

- •Prior to the vote, Alex G amended the motion to remove any mention of lunch as it is not being served due to the pandemic.
- •The item was voted on and passed: 4 (Y), 0 (N), 0 (A)
- B. Senior Symposium Swag Should the Outreach Committee recommend purchasing a new item for the Senior Symposium? In the past, a big hit at the Senior Symposium was the credit card magnifiers. We can order new ones, colors are limited, perhaps in black with white writing for the event. Please see supporting document, <a href="CC">CC</a>
  <a href="Magnifier Image">Magnifier Image</a>, to get an idea of what it looks like. The cost for 500 cc magnifiers, with setup and shipping comes to \$683.07, please see supporting document, <a href="Cost of CC Magnifiers">Cost of CC Magnifiers</a>. Possible motion MOTION: The ENC's Outreach Committee recommends that the board approve spending up to \$700 for 500 credit card magnifiers from 4imprint. Each magnifier will have the ENC's name and website. The cost includes the setup and shipping. Discussion and possible action.
  - •Alex G introduced the item and made the motion to approve. Jenny B. 2<sup>nd</sup>s.
  - •The item was opened to committee discussions. Following committee discussion, the item was opened to public comment.
  - •Pat B. commented that the cost should be increased to \$800 just in case.
  - •Alex G introduced an amendment and received a 2<sup>nd</sup> from Mike S.
  - •The item was opened for public comment.
  - •Following comments, the item was voted on and passed: 4 (Y), 0 (N), 0 (A)
- C. New Hand Out at Events to compliment the ENC Brochures Currently the ENC has a professional tri-fold flyer that we hand out at events. At an event we were handed a flyer from another NC, it's three, 8" x 11.5" sheets of paper, two of which are printed on both sides. The plus to printing flyers like the supporting document, <a href="Additional Flyer">Additional Flyer</a>, is that we can print smaller quantities for events and continuously update with new/current information or information specific to the event. Should the Outreach Committee come up with a similar flyer to present to the board for approval to print? NCs receive a significant discount for printing at Office Depot.

  Discussion and possible action.
  - Alex G introduced the item commenting that it could turn into a mini newsletter.
  - The item was opened to committee comments.
  - Following committee comments, it was determined that a mockup would be created and discussed at a future Outreach Committee meeting.
  - Alex G. will create the mockup.
- **D.** Movie at the Park July or in the Fall? Usually, the ENC hosts a movie at the park each July, close to the end of the month. FilmLA has, in the past, covered all the costs associated with the event because Encino is a film friendly community. The tradition has been suspended because of Covid. Should we continue the tradition by having a movie towards the last week in July or should we move the event to the Fall when it gets darker earlier? **Discussion and possible action.** 
  - •The item was introduced by Alex G. with the question of when should the ENC host our movie at the park.
  - The item was opened to committee and public comment.
  - •Following discussion it was decided that the we should explore a movie at the park later in the year which will help by being able to start the movie earlier.
  - •Pat B commented that she would like to be on the committee moving forward.

- E. Movie at the Park hosted by CD4 Councilmember Raman and the Encino Field Deputy, Kevin Sanchez-Morales would like to have a movie at the park event in May, this would be the responsibility of CD4 and the ENC will assist with promoting the event and be in attendance with a table, popcorn and handouts. We need to purchase new popcorn as our current ones have expired. Smart and Final has 2 36 counts boxes for \$50.38. MOTION: The ENC's Outreach Committee recommends that the board approve spending up to \$60 for the purchase of popcorn kits to use in the ENC popcorn machine at upcoming movie at the park events from Smart and Final or similar. Discussion and possible action.
  - Alex G introduced the item. The ENC would assist with promoting the movie and have a table at the event. Additionally the ENC would supply the popcorn
  - •Alex G moved the item, Jenny B 2nds. The item was opened to committee member comments
  - •Following committee member comments the item was opened to public comment.
  - •The item was voted on and passed: 4 (Y), 0 (N), 0 (A).
- F. Easter Egg Hunt at Encino Park RAP is requiring the Encino CC to host an egg hunt at Encino Park. The ENC has been invited to participate. We usually participate in the hunt at Los Encino but that is not occurring this year. Typically we have a table with some things for the kids, i.e. coloring. MOTION: The ENC's Outreach Committee requests that the board support spending up to \$275 for popcorn, coloring supplies and copies of images to be colored. The crayons, copies and popcorn may come from Office Depot (or similar).
  - •Alex G introduced the item and moved to approve the motion. Jenny B 2nds.
  - •The item was opened to committee discussion.
  - Following committee discussion, the item was opened to public comment.
  - •The item was voted on and passed: 4 (Y), 0 (N), 0 (A)
- G. Zoom license for the ENC With most pandemic restrictions being lifted, it is possible that some of board members may not want to meet in person and the Community Center requires proof of vaccination to enter (at this time) which may prohibit unvaccinated board members as well as members of the public who are not vaccinated. Additional considerations are who would be required to screen attendees and enforce the vaccine requirement. An idea has been introduced to have each NC purchase a Zoom license. Fees at this time are unknow but we have been given a price range of \$200 \$400 per year. To accommodate attendees, should the ENC prepare to purchase a Zoom license? MOTION: The ENC's Outreach Committee recommends that the board support purchasing our own Zoom license and allocating up to \$400 per year for the license. In addition, we request that the Finance Committee revise the operations budget to accommodate the new yearly charge as an operating expense.
  - •Alex G introduced the item and moved to approve the motion. Jenny B 2nds.
  - •The item was opened for discussion.
  - Following discussion the item was voted on and passed: 4 (Y), 0 (N), 0 (A)

- H. Increasing board member and stakeholder participation in the Outreach Committee We need to add more members to the Outreach Committee. We should invite friends that live in Encino to participate as Stakeholder committee members and see if anyone from the board would like to participate. Discussion and possible action
  - •The item was discussed and the topic will continue at future meetings.
- I. Possible mask give-a-way The CD4 office has received an abundance of masks and asked if we would partner up with them to have a mask give-a-way. With restrictions easing, thoughts on assisting with a mask give-a-way? If we do partner with them, we can help promote and distribute masks without and costs associated. During the pandemic, we teamed up with an organization and handed out masks at Genesta Park. Discussion and possible action.
  - •This item was introduced and opened for discussion.
  - •After discussion it was decided with the easing of restrictions, we should hold off on having a mask distribution day.
