2. New Business Action Items: Votes may be taken on all action items.

A. Discussion and possible action:

- Composting/Food Waste: The CA compost law is part of SB 1383, which was passed in 2016. The program will involve managing compostable material for residential and commercial waste, including food waste from grocery stores and restaurants. By the end of 2024, the law is expected to have taken effect in every municipality across California. What's happening in the City of Los Angeles? Shall we assign a task force to investigate and report back, maybe with a speaker, next month? LA Sanitation presentation to the NC Sustainability Alliance is <u>linked here</u>. - 2. Tree Watering: In conjunction with the ENC's Weed & Clean Project, some street trees may benefit from the installation of a slow release watering bag (approximately 20 gallons). Can we request the City install such bags if the property owner/business/ENC commits to regularly refilling them with water? Alternatively, the ENC could purchase them for a cost of approximately \$25 each. Treegator sold by various vendors including Forestry Distributing and Amazon.com. Not to exceed \$300.
- 3. Tree Removals: The ENC periodically receives notices of tree removal(s) from the City. Most recently a notice to remove a Coast Live Oak at 5115 Genesta Avenue in Encino dated August 20, 2022 was received on August 24, 2022 (CRM #1-2287670181). Concerns have been expressed about the timeliness of the notice given the requirement for a reply within three days and lack of details provided including the tree's exact location on the lot nor the project construction details. Should the ENC adopt a generalized policy regarding the proposed removal of protected trees so that timely responses can be provided to the City by the ENC?
