 - B. Brush clearance issues on Mulholland Drive between Calneva & Encino Hills Drive. Consider a resolution requesting prompt remediation of this hazard and inquiring what role the Encino Neighborhood council might play in such process. **After discussion the chair noted she would follow up with possible actions to take.**
 - C. .Brush and encampment clearance along Burbank, Woodley and Balboa Blvds: After being cleaned up for the first time in several years, these street medians are rapidly regrowing their stock of head-high weeds and Burbank Blvd. is filled with encampments and illegal dumping. Consider inquiring as to the plans for these areas this year and whether the Encino Neighborhood council might play a role in these activities. **.After discussion chair noted she would follow up with possible actions to take**
