4) Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.

Based in Encino and now in its 26th year, the Los Angeles Youth Orchestra consists of 135 student musicians aged 8-18 from over 60 schools across greater Los Angeles.

The funds will be used for 3 rehearsals and a free concert by the Los Angeles Youth Orchestra. The funds will pay for rehearsal space, concert space, and rental chairs.
