

DAYLIGHTING LAW NOTICE

Fact Sheet

On January 1, 2025, a new California Law, Assembly Bill 413 (AB 413), also known as the Daylighting to Save Lives Bill, took effect statewide.

What does the Daylighting Law do?

- Prohibits stopping, standing, or parking vehicles:
 - Within 20 ft of the approach side of any crosswalk; or
 - Within 15 ft of the approach side of any crosswalk with a curb extension.

Why Daylighting Matters?

- Nearly 36% of all pedestrian traffic fatalities in the unincorporated area of Los Angeles County occur at intersections.
- Daylighting enhances visibility for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists.

When will Enforcement begin?

- Parking Enforcement Detail will begin enforcing the law November 1, 2025.
- The violation will apply even if there's no posted signage or painted curb.
- The parking citation violation code is 22500(n)(1)(A) cvc with a fine of \$63.
