MINUTES OF THE TRAFFIC/TRANSPORTATION MEETING ENCINO NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL JANUARY 28, 2009

QUORUM determined: Kelson, H. Hand, C. Hand, Silver, Rosen, Bailey, Sullivan, Tuberman (guest) and Ken Firoozmand (LA DOT)
Excused absences: Grossman, Woods, Watson
Unexcused absences: Martayan, Quinn

1. Traffic Counts requested for Valley Vista @ Woodley (7-9 am) and Valley Vista @ Densmore (4-6 pm) . Discussion. Contact Sergio Valdez at LA DOT again. Neighbors need to take action.
2. 16030 Ventura Blvd. - request to move loading zone. 3/08 a parking meter was moved and the curb was painted to have a red zone of 58 feet. A new request to move the loading zone was denied.
3. Libbit @ Addison All-way Stop was denied. Libbit is a collector street and there is a stop sign at Morrison and Libbit. The DOT criteria states that Addison and Morrison are too close together to have another stop sign. The neighbors can pursue speed bumps as another alternative to slow traffic.
4. Motion: Silver 2nd: Rosen - Sent a letter to Jack Weiss to request the Tiger Team (tow trucks) to enforce the No Parking zone between Balboa and Woodley on Ventura Blvd. (CONSENT ITEM)
5. Motion: Kelson, 2nd Silver: Send a request to Cal Tans to study and implement methods to help move cars off of White Ave more quickly onto the Westbound 101 Westbound ramp at White Oak Ave. including, but not limited to, two cars per green ramp metered light and shortening the red light cycle as well as other ideas to alleviate severe congestion. (CONSENT ITEM)
6. Possible Crosswalk on Balboa @ Clark. Does not meet DOT standards. There is another crosswalk 400 feet North.
7. No Smoking/ Fire Area signs needed on Mulholland Dr. Motion: Kelson 2nd: Silver (CONSENT ITEM)

8. Request for the DOT to carefully reevaluate the signal timing and striping on Sepulveda Blvd between Greenleaf and Ventura Blvd. Be sure to CC the SONC and West Valley DOT. Request must be sent to East Valley DOT head Brian Gallagher.
