Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes Encino Chamber of Commerce 4935 Balboa Blvd., Encino Wednesday, May 20, 2009

1. Call to order by Chair, Tonya Barseghian, at 7:25pm; present were Hi Hand, Sherman Gamson, Kenneth Silk and Sharon Brewer (stakeholder). Excused absence: Diana Crews. Unexcused absence: Greg Martayan and Hal Sullivan.
Call for motion by Sherman Gamson, 2nd by Hi Hand:
Motion #1 by Sherman Gamson, 2nd by Hi Hand calls for Kenneth Silk to be a voting member of the Public Safety committee. Unanimous “for” and 1 abstains.
A quorum is established.
2. Approval of April 15, 2009 minutes, approved as written.
3. Code of Civility: Prior to meetings, committee members agreed to read and be mindful of the Code of Civility, as it will not be read aloud before each meeting any longer.
4. Old Business:
 - a. Teen CERT/DAC: Because of the city’s current budget cuts, weekend series of CERT will not be offered. Next CERT series begins the last week of June and continues seven weeks thereafter. Per Captain Avina’s suggestion, the committee will continue its efforts of offering local schools DAC. If the courses are successful, Teen CERT would be advised. For the time being, the committee will contact local schools to see if they are interested in DAC. The committee also made recommendations to the sample ENC/DAC flyer: target parents (PTA). Per LAUSD, they are fully trained and up to date with emergency preparedness, hence, the committee will be targeting non-LAUSD schools i.e. private, charter, parochial.
 - b. Fire Zone Signage moved to next meeting.
 - c. Encino Disaster Preparedness Summit Update: Several different organizations and agencies sent representatives to the Summit on May 8, ’09 at Providence Tarzana

Medical Center. The Summit was successful in that it was able to have an exchange of ideas to contribute to a community emergency plan. The agenda included the role of local government in a disaster, LA County/DRC/Hospital Preparedness Plan and other ways to get involved. Representatives were separated into different categories such as Medical, Communications, Shelter, and Transportation in order to discuss resources each organization could offer. We also discussed the incident command system with emphasis on operations, planning, logistics, and finance administration. Representatives are to meet again in June for a follow up.

5. New Business:

- a. CPAB Summit: The "CSI 2009 C-PAB Summit" is to take place on Saturday, June 6, 2009 at California State University, Los Angeles. With DONE's approval, LAPD and CPU are extending an invitation to each certified Neighborhood Council and requesting \$500.00 support towards the C-PAB and NC partnership. The NCs will be promoted throughout the event and will participate in Department training between C-PAB and NC members, etc... However, considering the Public Safety committee's budget a motion was brought forth. *Motion #2* by Hi Hand, 2nd by Sherman Gamson- to authorize the Chair of Public Safety to contact Rob Glushon for the authority to contact LAPD for privilege of representing Encino Neighborhood Council for a lesser amount, not to exceed \$150.00. Unanimous vote for, 1 abstains.
- b. LAPD: West Valley Update: May 5, 2009- West Valley detectives arrest missing man's brother in connection with his disappearance and murder.
 - May 5, 2009- Two males robbed a Money Tree check cashing store (7200 block of Tampa Ave.) at gunpoint and ran off with cash and other properties. There were no shots fired and no one was injured.
 - May 14, 2009- Two victims die in a fiery car crash in Encino on Burbank Blvd. near Balboa Blvd.
 - May 15, 2009- Man shot near 101 freeway off-ramp on Hayvenhurst Ave. and crashed into Encino Park. As of May 18, the driver/victim was in critical, but stable condition. The motive for the shooting remains unknown.
 - Miscellaneous Updates: According to DONE General Manager, Bonghwan Kim, as of May 19, 2009, the purchase of emergency preparedness bins and supplies must be suspended immediately.
 - SOS Survival Products- Emergency Preparedness Class on May 23, 2009 10am and 1pm (approximately 1 hour class) at 15705 Strathern St. #11 Van Nuys, CA 91406.
 - SOS Survival Products Parking Lot Sale and Preparedness Event to be held on June 12, 2009 and June 13, 2009 9am-4pm at 15705 Strathern St. #11 Van Nuys, CA 91406.

* As there was no further new business, the meeting adjourned at 9:25pm.
