 - (1) SCAG 2016 a) Sepulveda Tunnel LA996425 still on the books. The ENC already voted against this item 4/25/2012. MOTION: THE ENC DOES NOT SUPPORT A REVERSE LANE IN THE SEPULVEDA BLVD TUNNEL UNDER MULHOLLAND DR. THE NEW NORTHBOUND LANE ON SEPULVEDA BLVD FROM THE S 405 SKIRBALL EXIT TO THE SKIRBALL BRIDGE HAS REDUCED PM CONGESTION SIGNIFICANTLY. d. <u>Planning and Land Use (PLU) Committee</u> – Motion(s) passed at PLU Committee Meeting Tuesday, January 12, 2016: (1) Proposed 7-Eleven store to occupy 2,770 square feet on the ground floor at 15445 Ventura Blvd. Beer and Wine Off-Sale Permit and 24 Hours Operation. Tenant improvement to combine 3 existing retail spaces on the ground floor; unit 2 is 1,600 square feet, unit 3 is 800 square feet, and space 7 is 400 square feet totaling 2,800 square feet of an existing 11,200 square feet retail building with off-site sales of beer and wine products operating 24 hours a day.

Motion: The Encino Neighborhood Council Planning and Land Use Committee does not approve or support the project at 15445 Ventura Blvd as proposed by 7-Eleven. The Committee members believed the off site sale hours should be limited to the hours of 7AM to 11PM. It took that position due to late night public safety concerns. Cohen/ 2nd by Hudgins - 4/0/0 - Motion passed.

<u>PUBLIC INPUT AT ENC MEETINGS</u> - An opportunity for the public to address the Council or Speaker on agenda items will be provided before or during consideration of the item. Members of the public who wish to be recognized on any item are requested to complete a question card for each item they wish to address, and present the completed card(s) to the Sergeant-At-Arms. Speaker cards are available at the back of the meeting room. The Council will also provide an opportunity for the public to speak on any [Non-Agenda Items*] during "Public Comment". The Council may not take any action or discuss matters addressed in "Public Comments". However, the Council President may refer such matters to the appropriate Council Committees for further consideration.

* Public comments are limited to TWO (2) minutes per speaker.

ENC BOARD DISCUSSION AND TIME LIMITS – an ENC Board member's request to speak will be recognized by the President in the order requested. For any item, the Chairperson of the Committee, or the maker of the original motion shall have up to THREE (3) minutes to discuss the item. Board members may speak for up to TWO (2) minutes each on the matter unless extended by the President or Council. After all members desiring to speak on a question have had an opportunity to be heard once, the time for each Member desiring to speak again shall be limited to a maximum of ONE (1) minute unless extended by the President or Council. A motion calling the "Previous Question" may be introduced by any member during a Council debate. If adopted, this motion will terminate debate on a matter and the matter will then be submitted for a vote.

<u>VOTING AND DISPOSITION OF ITEMS</u> - Most motions require a majority vote of the Board member's present and voting will be by hand vote unless otherwise decided by the Council. Unless requested for further consideration by an ENC Board member, any item that has been forwarded to the Council by a unanimous committee vote shall be approved as a "Consent Item" without further discussion.

TO BE FURTHER NOTED TO ALL IN ATTENDANCE:

Posting of your personal information to the ENC or any public organization can be released upon a request to the ENC according to the CA Public Records Act. You are not required to post your personal information unless you choose to do so.
